

Sanitising Workplaces

Sanitising high-touch surfaces is a frontline hygiene service that protects your staff from the surface transmission of viruses. This is particularly important during the pandemic era we are now in.

We clean and sanitise the surfaces that people touch regularly using a powerful Anti-Viral Sanitiser, which is officially rated to be effective against coronavirus by the US Environmental Protection Agency.

Viruses can live for a long time (up to 48 hours) on surfaces like door handles and other objects people touch with their hands.

Promoting regular hand washing and having good environmental stewardship of cleaning and sanitisation is your best defence against transmission of the flu and other viruses in the workplace.

High-touch surfaces

High-touch surfaces experience a build up of soil and biofilm through hand and finger contact. This biofilm can harbour germs and viruses, which can be spread by human contact.

Viruses, including coronavirus and influenza, are killed by the correct application of an effective sanitiser. CrestClean recommends regularly sanitising surfaces that people frequently touch with Anti-Viral Sanitiser.

Sanitising process

Sanitising requires a 2-step process where surfaces are first cleaned to remove soil and biofilm build-up, and then sanitiser is applied. The service is carried out at agreed periods, i.e. daily, 3 x weekly, or weekly, in addition to our regular cleaning services.

The sanitiser has a residual effect, i.e. traces of sanitiser left on the surface will keep on killing any new pathogens that may land on the surface.

Regular sanitising
